Beginning Wednesday 1NOV2023 at 1PM, the cantonment area of Fort Indiantown Gap will be secured and access will be restricted to the garrison. After that time, all Outdoor Recreation participants seeking access inside the fence will require a valid government issued ID (driver license), which will be presented at the Access Control Point (ACP). The ACP is located on RT 934 just north of Schnitz Creek Brewery/Funck's Gas Station. This is the only access point to the controlled perimeter of the installation. Beginning Wednesday 1NOV Training Areas A-14, A-16, & A-17 will no longer be accessible to General Access Permit holders of the FTIG Outdoor Recreation program. The only areas that General Access Permit holders can access inside the controlled perimeter are A-32, A-33, & A-34. General Access Permit holders requesting access into the cantonment area for the purpose of hunting, scouting, or trapping during times that these 3 areas are closed will be denied access.

To gain access to A-32, A-33, & A-34 for hunting, scouting, or trapping:

- The areas must be open to hunting, scouting, or trapping
- Each individual must have a valid, printed copy of their FTIG iSportsman Permit
- Each individual must have a valid government issued ID
- Junior hunters/mentored youth must be accompanied by someone with a valid government issued ID and a FTIG iSportsman Permit
- Weapons for hunting must be stored in vehicle separate from ammunition
- Handguns may not be stored in passenger area of vehicle, must be stored separate of ammunition, and a valid permit to carry must be present

Hunters may be denied access for/but not limited to any of the following reasons:

- Current warrant for arrest outstanding
- Current Protection From Abuse against
- Prior felony arrest
- Multiple recent prior misdemeanor arrests
- Possession of drugs or illegal paraphernalia

In the future all visitors may be required to obtain a visitors badge for hunting. If that time comes, you will then be notified and asked to do so at the visitors center near the ACP during business hours.

When you come onto post you will see these "branding" signs at the gates. They do not represent specific gates for specific people. All open gates can and should be used by any and all personnel seeking to gain access. An example of these signs is represented in an attachment to this email labeled ACP Designs.

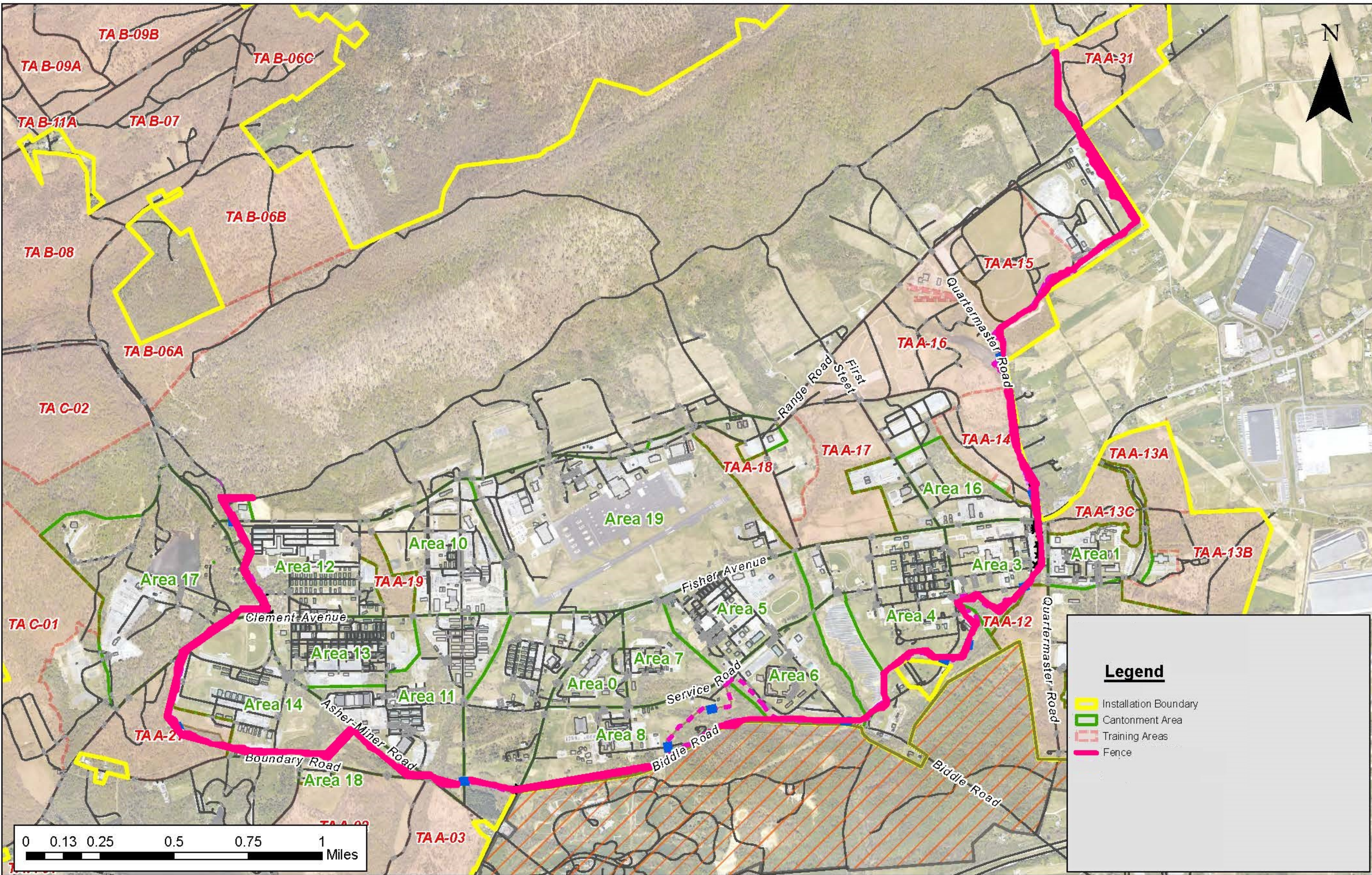

MEMORANDUM FOR All Fort Indiantown Gap Employees and Visitors

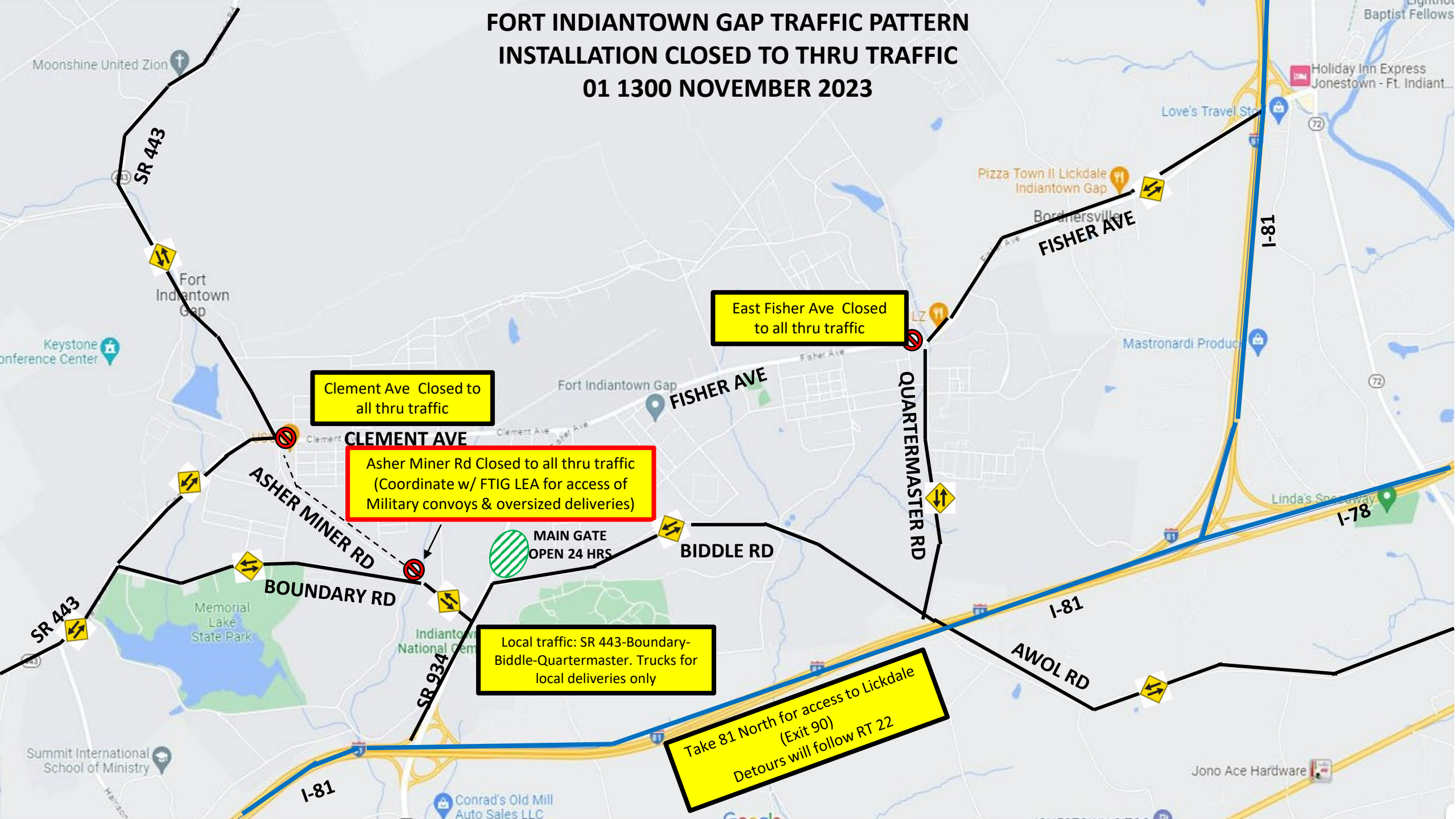
SUBJECT: Fort Indiantown Gap Restricted Access Procedures

1. Starting on 01 November 2023 at 1300, Fort Indiantown Gap (FTIG) will begin restricting access to the post. All personnel who need access to the post (full time employees, transient units, DoD personnel, delivery personnel, or visitors) will be required to show a valid state issued or federally issued photo identification (ID) card.
 - a. Examples of valid state issued IDs include: State Driver's license, State Identification Card, State Benefits Card, DMVA issued access card, and Law Enforcement Agency (LEA) credentials.
 - b. Examples of valid federally issued IDs include: Common Access Card (CAC), Retiree Cards, Passports, Passport Cards, LEA credentials, and Veterans Affairs photo ID.
 - c. Convoys will operate in accordance with (IAW) FTIG 190-13.
 - d. Delivery vehicles will utilize the "Truck Lanes" for access utilizing State or Federal photo ID.
2. The implementation of this procedure is temporary until further notice, resulting full implementation IAW 190-13. Future changes to access requirements will be transmitted well in advance to ensure adequate time for compliance.
3. The attached map shows the current roads that will remain open for personnel to reach the Access Control Point.
